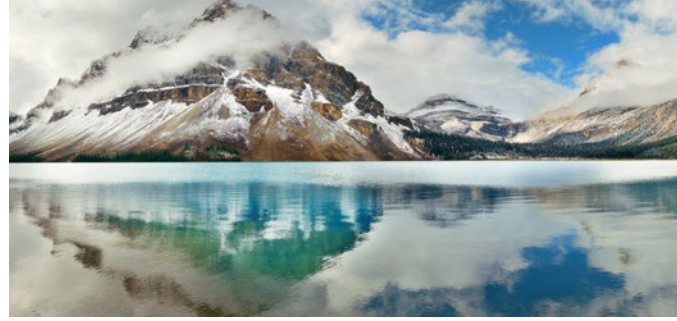

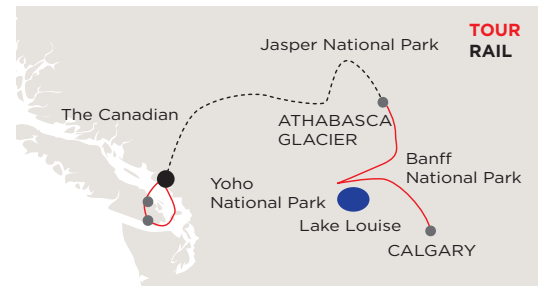

Day 1 – 12 May 2017 Arrive San Francisco	On arrival at San Francisco International Airport you will be met and transferred by seat-in-coach bus to your hotel and the rest of the day is free at your leisure.
Day 2 – 13 May 2017 Embark Cruise	The morning is free at your leisure, before an afternoon seat-in-coach transfer to Regent Seven Seas Voyager cruise to Alaska Meals: B D Lodging: on board Regent Seven Seas Mariner
Day 3 – 14 May 2017 At Sea	Spend the day cruising the Pacific Ocean Meals: B, L, D Lodging: on board Regent Seven Seas Mariner
Day 4 – 15 May 2017 Astoria, Oregon	Arrive 7am/Depart 3pm - Nestled against the wooded hills along the mouth of the Columbia River, Astoria is the oldest American settlement west of the Rockies. With its steep hills and beautiful Victorian homes, Astoria has been called the "Little San Francisco of the Pacific Northwest." Meals: B, L, D Lodging: on board Regent Seven Seas Mariner
Day 5 – 16 May 2017 At Sea	Spend the day cruising the Outside Passage Meals: B, L, D Lodging: on board Regent Seven Seas Mariner
Day 6 – 17 May 2017 Sitka, Alaska	Arrive 12pm/Depart 7pm - Founded by Russian fur traders as New Archangel in 1799, Sitka was the historic centre of Russia's Alaskan empire. On a clear day Sitka, the only city in southeast Alaska that actually fronts the Pacific Ocean, rivals Juneau for the sheer beauty of its surroundings. Meals: B, L, D Lodging: on board Regent Seven Seas Mariner
Day 7 – 18 May 2017 At Sea	Spend the day cruising the Hubbard Glacier Meals: B, L, D Lodging: on board Regent Seven Seas Mariner
Day 8 – 19 May 2017 Juneau, Alaska	Arrive 8am/Depart 6pm - In 1880, Joe Juneau and Richard Harris were prospecting for gold with the help of Indian guides. Here they discovered nuggets "as large as beans" at the mouth of the aptly named Gold Creek. Out of their discoveries came three of the largest gold digs in the world where more than \$150 million in gold was mined. Meals: B, L, D Lodging: on board Regent Seven Seas Mariner
Day 9 – 20 May 2017 Wrangell, Alaska	Arrive 12pm/Depart 11pm - One of Alaska's oldest settlements, the town boomed during the great Gold Rush of the late 19th century and Wrangell sported gambling halls, dance halls, booze, and lawlessness. Today, commercial fishing and timber still are the mainstays for Wrangell's economy. Meals: B, L, D Lodging: on board Regent Seven Seas Mariner
Day 10 – 21 May 2017 Ketchikan, Alaska	Arrive 8am/Depart 7pm - Ketchikan, on the southwest side of Revillagigedo Island, grew up around salmon canneries and sawmills. Ketchikan's name supposedly comes from the native term "Katch Kanna", which roughly translates: "spread wings of a thundering eagle." Meals: B, L, D Lodging: on board Regent Seven Seas Mariner
Day 11 – 22 May 2017 At Sea	Spend the day cruising the Inside Passage Meals: B, L, D Lodging: on board Regent Seven Seas Mariner
Day 12 – 23 May 2017 Victoria, Canada	Arrive 1pm/Depart 11:59pm - Victoria is a picture-perfect city exuding old-world charm, with fragrant and colorful flowers everywhere. Founded in 1843 by James Douglas of the Hudson's Bay Company, it was first known as Fort Victoria. By 1848, Vancouver Island was made a British colony. Meals: B, L, D Lodging: on board Regent Seven Seas Mariner
Day 13 – 24 May 2017 Vancouver, Canada	Arrive 7am - After disembarkation you will be met and transferred by seat-in-coach bus to the Fairmont Waterfront Hotel. Your hotel is located within easy walking distance of Vancouver's lively Gastown and Stanley Park. The rest of your day is at leisure or as about our special 2 night option to Whistler. Meals: B Lodging: Fairmont Waterfront Hotel
Day 14 – 25 May 2017 Vancouver, Canada	Enjoy the day free at your leisure. Meals: B Lodging: Fairmont Waterfront Hotel
Day 15 – 26 May 2017 Vancouver, Canada	Enjoy the day free at your leisure. Meals: B Lodging: Fairmont Waterfront Hotel

Day 18 – 29 May 2017 Victoria, Canada	Throughout your stay in Victoria, you'll discover more than a bit of British influence in its double-decker buses, horse-drawn carriages and formal gardens, all surrounded by the rustic beauty of the Pacific coast. You'll find floral beauty in exceptional form at The Butchart Gardens, begun over a century ago. During your visit this morning, explore what has grown to encompass 55 magnificent acres of flowers and show gardens, including the Japanese, Italian and Rose gardens. Meals: B, D Lodging: Hotel Grand Pacific
Day 19 – 30 May 2017 Board Train	Morning is free to spend as you wish, perhaps visiting the Royal BC Museum with your Tauck-included tickets. Meet up this afternoon for a short walk from the hotel to board a float plane; enjoy flightseeing over the pristine Gulf Islands en route to Coal Harbour in the city of Vancouver. Your next stop is Vancouver's historic Gastown district; explore at leisure before dinner and a champagne send-off on VIA Rail's The Canadian for an overnight journey to the awe-inspiring Canadian Rockies. Watch for bears, elk, bighorn sheep, and mountain goats, especially in the spring and fall. Continue on to your chateau-style hotel on the edge of Lake Louise overlooking Victoria Glacier, for a night in a Lake View room. Meals: B, L, D Lodging: The Fairmont Chateau Lake Louise
Day 23 – 3 June 2017 Lake Louise to Banff, Canada	Spend the morning at leisure indulging in the amenities and natural beauty of your Lake Louise resort. This afternoon, enjoy a change of scenery and resorts when you settle into your resort in Banff National Park. Enjoy dinner this evening at leisure at The Fairmont Banff Springs. Meals: B, L, D Lodging: Fairmont Banff Springs

SEAT CHANGES

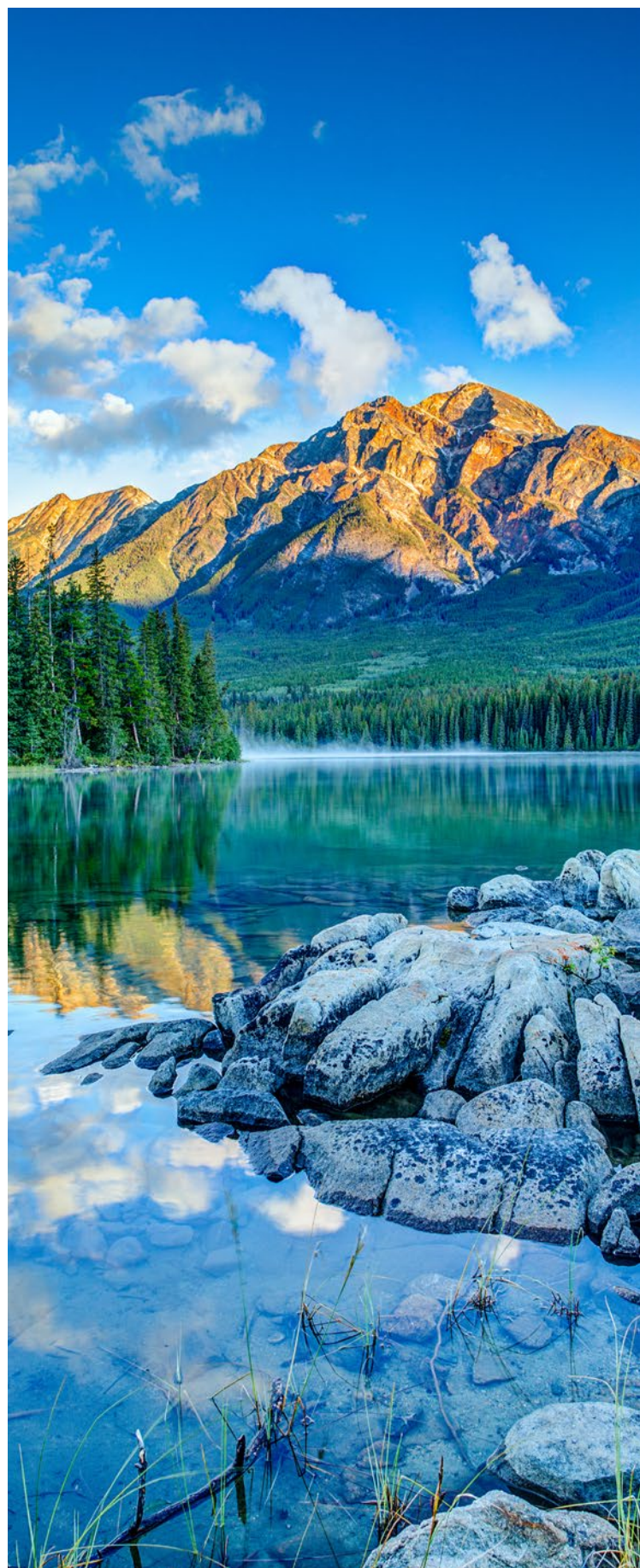
A seat rotation system will apply on board our coach whilst touring.
